Community Grants Timeline

Grant Application Training June

CFCSRA staff hosts information session on Community Grants giving an overview of the application process, eligibility requirements, and any changes to the application or process from prior years. The application goes live immediately following training sessions.

Early Deadline July

All applicants are given the opportunity to submit their application for early review by CFCSRA staff. Staff review applications and make suggestions for improvements if needed.

Final Deadline and Review August

All grant applications are due. CFCSRA staff review applications ensuring applicants meet funding criteria, provide services in the 6-county service area, and have completed all sections of the application.

Site Visits October

Community volunteers are assigned a group of organizations. They review applications and conduct site visits on every organization in their grouping. Panels discuss their thoughts and experiences, and then rank the organizations for funding.

Board Approval November

Panel rankings are submitted to the Community Foundation Board for final approval.

Press Conference December

CFCSRA hosts its annual press conference to officially announce and congratulate area nonprofits that were selected to receive a Community Grant Award.

Awards Distributed January

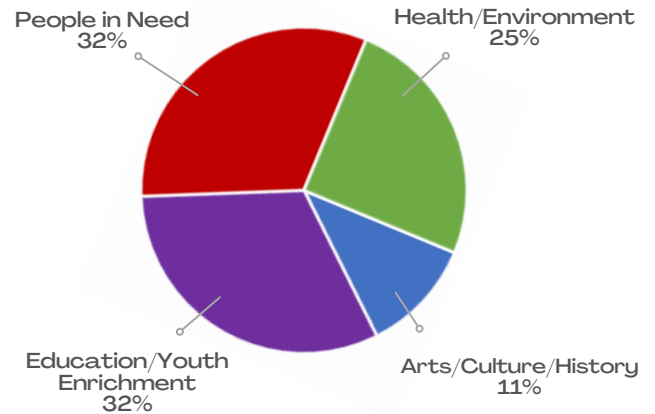
Grant funds are distributed to organizations in early January to be used as outlined in their grant request.

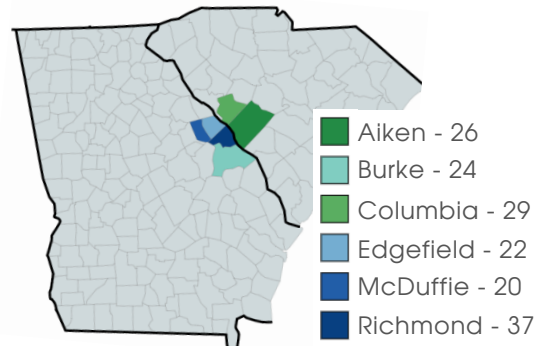
